**No Jackets, plaiting optional**

**MEMBERSHIP:** There is no day membership available for ENT shows. All competitors have to hold either a **Competitor or Participant** membership.

**REFUNDS:** Refunds are subject to the production of a Vet or Doctors certificate stating that the horse/rider was suffering a condition that would prevent them from competing. Incorrect entries WILL NOT be refunded and a \$20 administration fee will be charged

**PAYMENT:** All entries must be submitted via Nominate by 4pm 24/3/17 [www.nominate.com.au](http://www.nominate.com.au) Postal & email entries **will not** be accepted. **\$5 per class** is payable

**COMPETITORS:** All competitors compete at their own risk. For classes determined by age, age is at the day of competition.

**PROTEST:** Any protest accompanied by a non-refundable fee of **\$100** must be in writing, and handed to the Ringmaster, within **15 minutes** of the incident. Ruling on the protest by the Disputes Committee will be final.

**ENT Show Horse reserves the right to transfer any exhibit from any class to another and reject any entrant for a single class or the whole event.** ☒

**FEED & WATERING:** Whilst horses are on the Reserve the feeding and watering of them is the responsibility of the owner/exhibitor.

**HEALTH:** All horses must be free from contagious disease. Veterinary inspections may be carried out at any time and horses which, in the opinion of the Veterinarian, show signs of contagious disease, shall, if the organisers so order, be removed from the Reserve by the exhibitor at his/her expense.

**ETIQUETTE:** Competitors at all times will display correct manners to judges and officials. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the remainder of the Show and further action may be taken at the discretion of the organisers.

**ILL TREATMENT OF HORSES:** At anytime, anywhere on the Reserve, ill treatment of horses will not be tolerated and will result in automatic disqualification from further competition.

**TIMES:** Order of events shown in the program is a guide only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are ready for any event in which they are entering. The organisers reserve the right to vary the order and times of events as they see fit.

**CHAMPIONSHIPS:** The second place getters in all classes that qualify for Champion must stand-by, and the horse/rider that placed second to the horse/rider sashed. Champion will be required for the judging of the Reserve Champion.

**ATTIRE:** To be in accordance with EA rules. Suitable attire must be worn by all riders. Riders to wear light coloured jodhpurs or jeans, with a T-Shirt or open Ratcatcher with sleeves. No Jackets, vests, or ties. EA rules apply for all equipment regulations, including helmets, gloves etc. Saddle cloths, dressage saddle cloth and numnahs of any colour or style are allowed. Any handler or rider, who, in the opinion of the organisers, is not properly attired, will not be allowed to compete.

**APPROVED HEADGEAR:** Protective headgear must conform with one of the current approved safety standards:

- Current Australian standard AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI Global marked.
- New Australian standard ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI Global marked.
- Current American standard ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) provided they are SEI marked.
- Current American standard SNELL E2001.
- Current British standard PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked.
- Interim European Standard VG1 (01.040: 2014-12) with or without BSI Kitemark.

**LEADING REIN:** Due to being an unofficial show all horses and riders are eligible to compete in leading rein... snaffle bridle only and attendant must fix the leading rein to the noseband; and at all times lead with the rein in the left hand; string or any aid fastened to the saddle to keep the pony's head in position is not permitted; No spurs or whips; Handler may carry a cane.

**BEGINNER RIDER:** Is a class restricted for riders whom aren't confident. This class is designed for riders to go out and have a go. The riders don't have to canter if they do not wish to.

**NEWCOMER HACK/HUNTER:** For horses three years of age and over that have NOT competed Under Saddle, excluding Racing, prior to 1 January 2017. To be ridden in a jointed Snaffle Bit. Nose Band permitted.

**PRELIMINARY RIDER AND HACK CLASSES:** Preliminary Rider or Hack/Hunter is one that has not been placed 1st, Champion or Reserve in an Open ridden Hack class/event at any Royal Show or has never been the Winner or Runner Up at the Grand National, any State HOTY Title or has never been the Winner of any HOTY Intermediate or Preliminary Title.

**HUNTER / HACK CLASSES:** Horses may only compete as either a Hack or Show Hunter **NOT BOTH**.

**MEASURING:** measuring is not required for this show. Horses can only compete in one height class.
