Microchipping will be compulsory for all horses competing officially from July 1st 2011.

In accordance with Equestrian Australia General Regulations, all new horses registered from 1 July 2008 must be microchipped, and from 1 July 2011 all horses competing in official competition must be microchipped. General Regulations can be found on the EA National website: www.equestrian.org.au

Extract:

Equestrian Australia General Regulations,
Article 114 – Horse Identification

3. From 01 July 2008, to get registered with EA, all horse must have a microchip meeting Australian Standard AS5018/5019 inserted. (Standard amended 13 June 2008)

4. From 01 July 2011, all horses participating in Official competition must have a microchip meeting Australian Standard AS 5018/5019 inserted. (Date amended on 16 May 2008)
