The goal of this event is to provide a training opportunity for Interschool riders to participate during COVID-19 event restrictions.

** This event will be classified as "Participant" and will not be a "Competitive" (Official) event, therefore the results from this activity cannot be used for any qualification purposes**

Dressage and Show Horse Classes

All classes will be judged by EA accredited judges appropriate to the level, as per the Equestrian Australia National Discipline Rules effective 1 January 2021.

\$25 per class \$5 Administration fee per horse Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place. Prizes will be awarded to 3rd place.



Conditions of Entry & General Information

1. Membership and Horse Registration:

- Riders are to be currently enrolled in school and must be current Competitive members of EA and Horses/Ponies must be EA life registered and actively involved in the Interschool Equestrian program
- An entry check will be conducted on membership and eligibility
- 2021 State Team Members these classes are for those riders that have been selected as part of their Interschool State Team (this is up to each State's discretion).
- New Zealand based Interschool riders are also invited to participate

2. Prizes

- Rosettes will be awarded to 6th place
- Horseland Vouchers will be awarded to 3rd place
- Hygain Vouchers will be awarded to 3rd place
- Spot prizes of Horseland vouchers and Hygain vouchers will awarded at Judges' and OC's discretion.

3. Arena requirements – Dressage

- Tests must be conducted in an approximately 60m x 20m arena, either in a specifically constructed arena or a grass paddock
- Arena boundary must be clearly demarcated by a fence, poles, cones or other obvious safely constructed boundary
- Arena letters must be clearly marked and in the correct position around the arena

Arena requirements – Show Horse

- Workouts must be conducted in any appropriately sized area

4. Rider attire requirements

• It is an expectation that riders and their horses are neatly presented in either their Interschool competition uniform, Interschool State Team uniform (only for State Team classes) or discipline compliant competition attire.

5. Video requirements

- Videos must be taken from C for Dressage and from the Judge's position for Show Horse
- Video from a competition performance will be accepted as long as it is compliant with the video requirements listed
- Videos must be clear with minimal shaking
- Videos must be taken in one continuous viewing movements cannot be cut and pasted together
- Videos are not to be edited to include effects or enhancing
- Appropriate zooming is highly encouraged to assist the judges. Riders may lose marks if the judge is unable to accurately view the movement
- Submitted videos must have been taken after 1 July 2021
- On close of entries and following entry checks entrants will need to join the closed Facebook group 2021 Hygain Interschool Virtual Challenge <u>https://www.facebook.com/groups/2021hygaininterschoolvirtualchallenge/</u>
- A post/thread will be created for each class. Participants are to post their video in the comments section of their nominated class/es. Participants may upload their video to YouTube or similar and post the link in the comments.
- Riders who do not have access to Facebook can email their video link to interschool@equestrianqld.com.au and Interschool Queensland will post the link on Facebook on their behalf
- Only one video per combination per class can be uploaded
- Videos will be deleted if submitted after the video submission closing time
- 6. Callers: No callers are permitted
- 7. Horse grading eligibility for levels: Official grading will be taken at the date of the close of entries. Horses must meet EA grading requirements as per rule 4.8.3.2 for grading eligibility.

8. Saddlery and Equipment

- All EA rules apply
- Bandages / boots on horses will not be allowed
- Jumping saddles are permitted for Dressage tests.
- 9. **Protective Headgear:** For all riders approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when training, warming up or participating in this event. Please refer to rule 5.2 for the list of standards that headgear must comply with.
- 10. Presentation: Horses are to be neatly presented; plaiting is not compulsory.
- 11. Entries: can only be made online at <u>www.nominate.com.au</u>. Incomplete information may result in the entry not being accepted. Riders may enter in no more than 2 classes.
- 12. Results will be posted in the comments section of each class within 14 days
- 13. Test sheets will be sent via email on completion of judging.
- 14. Event organisers reserve the right to combine classes.

Scratchings, Withdrawals and Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced within 24 hours of the closing date of the event. In such cases, 25% of the entry fees will be retained by the OC. Entry fees will be refunded in full for scratchings before the closing date of entries. The administration fee will **not be refunded**.

- 15. **Indemnity**: Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, undertake to indemnify the Committee against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Riders are required to acknowledge the Declaration form included on Nominate.com.au. Failure to agree to this condition will result in non-acceptance of the nomination.
- 16. **Code of conduct:** It is a condition of participation at this event that each person submitting an entry and their associates are bound by the rules, policies and by-laws of Equestrian Australia. This includes comments made on social media. Any complaints or conflicts should be managed with respect through official channels. As per EA Disciplinary By-Laws 3(j) any other person or organisation (for example, a parent/guardian, spectator or sponsor) who or which agrees, in writing or otherwise (whether on a ticket, entry form, conditions of entry displayed at a venue etc) to be bound by these By-Laws. Any rider, parent, official or associate to be found in breach of these By-Laws will be render the rider's entry forfeit with no refund of entry fees.
- Protests and Appeals: Objections must be in writing and accompanied by a deposit fee of \$150.00 (refer EA Gen. Regs) Art. 163/164/165). Attention is drawn to Rule 1.5 of EA Dressage Rules. Protests must be lodged with Interschool Queensland within 24 hours of results being posted.

- 1. Horse riding is a dangerous activity and can result in serious injury (including death) and loss.
- 2. All persons who ride, or tend, a horse as part of this event do so entirely at their own risk.
- 3. Neither the Organising Committee of any event to which these rules apply, or the EA, accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
