GENERAL RULES AND CONDITIONS

The event is to be run under Equestrian Australia (EA) rules and by-laws in so far as they are applicable to this event and shall include any other rules formulated by Equestrian NT (ENT) and Darwin Show Jumping Club (DSJC). We strongly recommend that all competitors obtain a copy of the relevant EA rules through the ENT website: www.nt.equestrian.org.au

ENTRIES & FEES

Entries close at 9.00pm on Thursday 5 August 2021. Late entries will not be accepted.

All entries must be submitted via Global Entries Online: www.globalentriesonline.com.au.

Horses may compete in a maximum of three (3) classes per day.

Horses may only compete in one Grand Prix competition – that is, a horse may only compete in *either* class 3 or 10, not both.

HORS CONCOURS (HC)

Horses are permitted to enter classes as Hors Concours ('HC'), in line with article number 251 5 of the EA Jumping rules. An extract is provided below:

- 5. Hors Concours. A horse, which is not fully eligible for a particular competition, may be allowed to take part in that competition Horse Concours, subject to the following conditions:
 - 5.1 Permission is entirely at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
 - 5.2 The judge must be informed that permission has been given.
 - 5.3 The rider is subject to the rules as if he/she were an athlete.
 - 5.4 The owner, rider and horse must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.
 - 5.5 A horse, which has competed at an event Hors Concours, is not allowed to compete subsequently for prizes on that day at that event in the same ring.

SWABBING

Drug testing of horses (swabbing) will occur in accordance with the EA National Medication Control Policy and Equine Anti Doping and Medical Control rules. Rule details are available at www.equestrian.org.au.



NT CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE

JUNIOR TITLE: A Junior is a rider aged under 18 years as at 7 August 2021

The title of "2021 NT Junior Jumping Champion" will be awarded on the following basis:

- The rider must be a resident of the Northern Territory (or reside within 100 km of the NT border, consistent with EA membership regulations)
- Championship Points for placing in the eligible classes will be allocated on the basis of $1^{st} = 4pts$, $2^{nd} = 2pts$, $3^{rd} = 1pt$
- The horse & rider combination with the highest number of Championship Points across 3 events (listed below) will be awarded the relevant Championship
 - 1. Same as senior (if the rider was competing in the Open Grand Prix); or
 - 2. A combination of the Restricted Grand Prix (class 3), plus either class 2 or 4 on Saturday, and either class 8 or 9 on Sunday
- In the event of equality of the highest number of Championship Points, the horse & rider combination with the higher placing in the relevant Grand Prix will be awarded the Championship. If equality still exists, the horse that placed the highest in Class 10 will be awarded the Championship.

SENIOR TITLE: A Senior is a rider aged 18 years or over as at 7 August 2021

The title of "2021 NT Senior Jumping Champion" will be awarded on the following basis:

- The rider must be a resident of the Northern Territory (or reside within 100 km of the NT border, consistent with EA membership regulations)
- Championship points for placing in the eligible classes will be allocated on the basis of $1^{st} = 4pts$, $2^{nd} = 2pts$, $3^{rd} = 1pt$
- ♦ The horse & rider combination must compete in class 10 (ENT Open Grand Prix)
- The horse & rider combination must compete in
 - 1. Either class 5 or 6; and
 - 2. Either class 9 or 13
- The horse & rider combination with the highest number of Championship Points across 3 events (Class 10 plus either class 5 or 6, and either class 9 or 13, whichever is the higher in points) will be awarded the relevant Championship
- In the event of equality of the highest number of Championship Points, the horse & rider combination with the higher placing in the relevant Grand Prix will be awarded the Championship



PROTESTS

Any objection or protest must be made in writing, signed and handed to the Chief Steward with a fee of \$50 prior to the commencement of judging for the class concerned or within thirty minutes after presentations for that class. The Ground Jury shall determine the objection and will call such evidence as they think fit. If the decision goes against the protestor, he/she will forfeit his/her fee of \$50 and be liable for any expenses occasioned by the objection. Should the objection be allowed by the Ground Jury, the \$50 fee will be refunded.

Should the protestor wish to appeal the Ground Jury's decision, he/she must lodge an appeal in accordance with the rules of EA.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, undertake to indemnify the Committee against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purposes of any claim under this indemnity. Neither ENT, nor the organising committee or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, riders, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.
