General Rules and Conditions

The event is to be run under EA National Show Horse Rules and by-laws in so far as they are applicable to this event and shall include any other event specific rules set out by the event organiser, Darwin Show Horse Club Inc. It is the responsibility of all competitors to be familiar with the applicable rules at the time of entry https://www.equestrian.org.au/showhorse. and DSHC entry and event info at www.nominate.com.au and ENT Pre Royal Event rules on ENT website.

All competitors compete under their own risk.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Class Cost for Members/Day Members

Class cost \$8.00 per class for Members Class cost \$10.00 per class for Day Members All entries must be submitted via Nominate: <u>www.nominate.com.au</u>.

Day Membership

Day membership is available - \$25.00. Day membership is required for non DSHC members who wish to compete for the day.

If electing Day Membership you agree that neither Darwin Show Horse Club Inc, participants, officials, volunteers, medical personnel, any persons, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event shall be under any liability whatsoever for the death or any bodily injury, loss or damage which may be suffered or incurred by you at/during the event.

All day membership entries must be submitted via Nominate: <u>www.nominate.com.au</u>.

Horse/Pony Classes

Horses/ponies entered do not need to be EA registered.

Horses/ponies can not compete in both Hack and Show Hunter classes.

Horses/ponies must be 3 years of age or over at 1 August.

For Childs classes the rider must be aged between 5 years and under 18 years as of 1st January in the year of the event with exception of Leading Rein who are eligible to compete the day they turn 5 years old. Evidence of age to be provided if required.

For Small Show and Show Hunter ponies 12hh and under - rider must be 14 years and under.

All horses/ponies entered in height classes must hold a current unofficial statement of measuring or official measuring card with either NTSHA or Equestrian Australia. Measuring cards must be produced if requested.

Newcomer Classes

A horse/pony 3 years or over that has not competed under saddle (racing excepted) prior to 1 January 2022 are eligible. The horse/pony must be shown in a snaffle bridle only. Nose band permitted.

Rider Classes

Riders and/or Handlers must be current financial members of Darwin Show Horse Club .

Riders may only compete in the class they are eligible for. Age is at the 1st January in the year of the event.

Novice Classes

Novice Rider or Hunter/Show Hack is one that has not placed 1st in any Open Class or Champion or Reserve Champion at any Royal Show, or has never been the winner or runner up (1st and 2nd) at any State Horse of the Year (Australasian Show Horse or Equestrian Australia).





EA Classes

Riders must be financial members (competitive or participant level) of ENT at time of entry.

Childs Classes/Lead Rein Classes

Childs classes are for riders 5 years and under 18 years on the 1st of January of each year (excluding Leading Rein). For Lead Rein riders turning 5 years are eligible to compete the day they turn 5 years old.

Ladies/Gents Classes

Ladies/Gents Classes are for riders 18 years and over. Age determined on the 1st of January of each year.

Championship Classes

First place getters in eligible classes are eligible to ride for Champion. Second place getters to be on stand by for Reserve.

Conflict of Interest

A Competitor may not exhibit before a judge if within the period of six months prior to the date of competition:

- the Competitor is a member of the Judge's family
- the Competitor has represented the Judge or competed on a horse owned by the judge
- the horse or any horse was owned or leased by:
- the Judge;
- any member of the Judge's family;
- the Judge's employer, employee or business partner.
- the Judge or his business partner provided privately arranged tuition to the horse or competitor(not including group clinics)
- the Competitor has given privately arranged tuition to the Judge or trained or prepared a horse owned or leased by the Judge, (not including group clinics)
- the Competitor is employed, has been employed by or has been a business partner of the Judge
- In addition to the above bullet points a competitor may not exhibit before a judge if he or his family has provided private accommodation for the Judge within a 3 month period prior to or during the event.

A Judge or his family shall not visit neither the competitors nor the competitors horses, nor inspect or discuss any horse entered in the event for the duration of the show, except as required for judging and where permitted by rule below.

No person shall approach a Judge for the duration of the event unless they first obtain permission from the Ring Master or Ring Steward. A competitor seeking the opinion of a Judge must do so under the supervision of a Steward.

Rider Fall/Concussion Policy

In the event of a fall by horse or competitor, it will be the decision of the Judge or Ground Jury, or if there is no Ground Jury, a representative of the organising committee, (informed if necessary by a doctor or medical officer in the case of a rider or a vet or horse welfare officer in the case of a horse), as to whether the rider or horse can continue to compete. Upon recognition of any suspicion of concussion, the competitor will be removed from competition. Refer EA 's policy and protocol statements effective 1st July 2019 with regards to suspected concussion.

Riders must be mounted on entering and leaving the arena on penalty of elimination. If during a workout, or on the circle there is a fall of horse and/or rider it will entail elimination from that class. If a horse leaves the workout area, other than at the direction of a judge or official, it will entail elimination from that class.

The Judge has the power to eliminate a horse or rider if it is deemed by the judge to be erratic and unruly or a danger to any other competitor or horse.

Refund Policy

Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries, except in the event of a horse or rider being unfit to compete and whereby the competitor has advised the organising committee of their withdrawal prior to the start of the competition. In all such instances a medical or vet certificate must be received by the organising committee within 72 hours of the event stating that the horse/rider was suffering a condition that would prevent them from competing. Prizes

All prizes must be collected on the day, if they are not collected; the prize will be forfeited. Ribbons to 4th place, Sashes and Pryde's EasiFeed for Championship classes where donated .

Presentations

Presentations will be mounted and will take place at the completion of each class.

Stallions

Stallions are not permitted in any class at this event.

Judges Decision

Judges (Ground Jury) decision shall be final subject to the outcome of any protest, report or investigation made within the Rules.

Appeals Committee

Responsible for:

- dealing with protests referred to it respect of any matter occurring during or in connection with an ENT event including the matters must be made to the Appeals Committee during its period of jurisdiction
- dealing with appeals against decisions of the Ground Jury and all cases of infringements of any rules for which the Ground Jury is not responsible
- inviting any person deemed necessary to help them reach a decision.
- at least one judge from the competition in which the incident occurred must be consulted. Any objection
 or protest must be made in writing, signed and handed to the Chief Steward (and forwarded to the
 Appeals Committee), with a fee of \$100 prior to the commencement of judging for the class concerned
 or within thirty (30) minutes after presentations of sashes. The Ground Jury shall determine the
 objection and will call such evidence as they think fit. If the decision goes against the protestor, he/she
 will forfeit his/her fee of \$100 and be liable for any expenses occasioned by the objection. Should the
 objection be allowed by the Ground Jury, the \$100 fee will be refunded.
- Should the protestor wish to appeal the Ground Jury's decision, he/she must lodge an appeal in accordance with the rules of Equestrian Australia.
- The decision of the Appeals Committee is final.

Etiquette

Competitors/exhibitors and spectators must always display correct manners and respect to judges and officials and all other competitors/exhibitors and spectators. Failure to do so will result in elimination or exclusion from the event.

<u>Times</u>

The order of events shown in the program schedule is a guide only. It is the responsibility of competitors to ensure they are ready for any class they are entering. The organising committee reserves the right to vary the order and times of classes as they see fit.

<u>Attire</u>

To be in accordance with EA National Show Horse rules. Suitable attire must be worn by all riders.

Swabbing

The random swabbing of horses can occur at any time during an EA/ENT event. Be prepared to produce your EA Horse Registration papers to confirm the identification of your horse. For more information regarding banned substances please visit the FEI website Clean Sport for Horses website.

Close of Entries

Entries close at 5.00pm (NT Standard Time) on Wednesday 6th of July 2022. Late entries may only be accepted at the discretion of the Event /Organising Committee. All entries must be submitted via Nominate: <u>www.nominate.com.au</u>.
