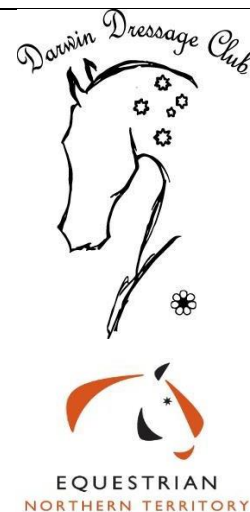

This seminar will aim to provide education and an opportunity for discussion between judges and dressage enthusiasts to find the standard for their assessment of dressage tests. The seminar can be used for re-accreditation purposes for current G level judges. For reaccreditation purposes the judge must be in attendance for the entire duration of the seminar and be an active participant (excluding the shadow judging on Sunday).

PLEASE NOTE: For those participants attending to obtain accreditation you must undertake the following steps, in addition to attending the seminar.

You must be:

- at least 17 years of age
- a current EA member of at least Supporter category
- complete G level expression of interest form
- complete the current G level open rule book test (ORBT) with a pass mark of at least 90%
- undertake two assessed sit-ins of at least 2 hours duration
- shadow judge an entire Preliminary or an entire Novice competition with at least 10 horses. A total minimum of 20 horses to be judged overall

Darwin Dressage Club (DDC) in conjunction with Equestrian Northern Territory (ENT) will make every attempt to provide the required number of horses to complete your shadow judging requirements. However, this cannot be guaranteed and may be required to do additional shadow judging on another date with a different judge mentor/educator.

All dressage riders and coaches are encouraged to attend!
