

Interschool NT Fundraising

The following provides a guideline for team or individual fundraising activities, as either team or squad members of the NT Interschool Team. Fundraising for the team is expected by all squad/team members.

To be divided between the whole team

- Australia wide grants
- NT grants
- Political donations
- Industry sponsorship (eg Saddleworld NT, Stockfeed shop etc in return for publishing logos etc)
- Other corporate sponsorship

To be divided between individuals Individual or small group fundraising (raffles etc to be divided among those who attended/worked for it)

- Industry specific donations (eg TRNT)
- Individual grants i.e. NT and AG Grants for competitors
- School donations
- Individual sponsorships (eg local business)

ENT Logo

Any use of the ENT Logo must be authorised. Team activities can use the logo, individual activities cannot use the logo.

Interschool NT Logo

Any use of the Interschool NT Logo must be authorised. Team activities can use the logo, individual activities cannot use the logo.

Food Sales

When selling food you must ensure all the required health standards are adhered to. Food safety in the NT is governed by the Food Act 2016 (NT). This Act requires that all food sold in the NT is safe and suitable for human consumption and meets all standards set out in the Food Standards Code.

Individual Fundraising

All individual fundraising activities must clearly state what will happens to funds raised in the event the individual does not get selected for the team, or is selected but doesn't attend the national event. ENT preference, any monies raised goes to the team.
